Public statement policy

Mission statement: The Washington State Academy of Sciences (WSAS) provides expert scientific and engineering analysis to inform public policy-making, and works to increase the role and visibility of science in the State of Washington.

Study committee reports are the main official products of the WSAS. Whether studies are requested by external sponsors or initiated and funded by the WSAS, study reports summarize the analyses and conclusions of committees established under the guidelines of the WSAS. Reports are vetted by the WSAS review process and approved for publication by the Board of Directors.

WSAS does not recommend policy. It does not take positions on contested public issues. Its analyses and conclusions are strictly non-partisan. It does not accept commissions for studies designed to advocate particular legislation. Its studies and resultant peer-reviewed and board-approved reports provide the basis for informed public discussion and decision.

No statement or document that has not been approved by the Board and posted on the website for public access should be considered an authorized statement or recommendation of WSAS.
